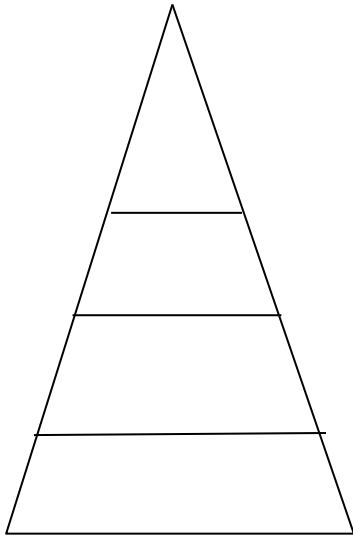
*The social structure in Athens was based on class. Class means*
